

It is an OFFENCE to bring raw game, meat or poultry without official certificate into Hong Kong

An offender shall be liable on conviction to a fine of HK\$50,000 and to imprisonment for 6 months.

Travellers should make declaration to Customs officers upon arrival if they are bringing any game, meat or poultry.

- In accordance with the Imported Game, Meat and Poultry Regulations (Chapter 132AK, Laws of Hong Kong), it is an offence to bring any game, meat or poultry into Hong Kong without official certificate issued by the food authority of the place of origin and / or without prior written permission granted by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department.
- An offender shall be liable on conviction to a fine of HK\$50,000 and to imprisonment for 6 months. DO NOT act against the law.
- Do NOT buy any game, meat or poultry without hygiene inspection and official certificate as they may pose a health risk to consumers.
- Travellers should note that under normal circumstances, food authorities of different places only issue official certificates to food traders for business purposes. Persons who wish to obtain such certificates for bringing game, meat or poultry into Hong Kong should check with the relevant authority in the place of origin and make application where there are arrangements for issuance of official certificates to individuals.
