# (1) CFS urges public not to consume several kinds of milk imported without import permission

CFS announced on 24 August 2021 and 27 August 2021 that the CFS has found several kind of milk imported without import permission approved by the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene (DFEH) at the retail level.

#### (2) Clonorchis sinensis in Raw Freshwater Fish

Infection of *Clonorchis sinensis* is endemic in Mainland China, Taiwan, Korea and some other countries and areas in Southeast Asia. It is roughly estimated that *Clonorchis sinensis* contributes to more than 80% of local human cases of enteric parasites. People are infected by consuming raw or undercooked freshwater fish containing metacercariae.
