(4) CFS announces risk assessment study results on industrially produced trans fatty acids content in prepackaged and non-prepackaged food

The CFS of the FEHD announced on November 9 the results of a risk assessment study on industrially produced trans fatty acids (IP-TFA) content in prepackaged and non-prepackaged food. To conduct the study on IP-TFA content, the CFS collected 149 food

items from five food categories, namely fats and oils, margarines and spreads, prepackaged foods, ready-to-eat foods and miscellaneous local specialties.
