# (1) <u>Proposed Amendments to the Food Adulteration (Metallic Contamination)</u> <u>Regulations</u>

The Government has launched a public consultation exercise on the proposed amendments to the Food Adulteration (Metallic Contamination) Regulations (Cap. 132V). Two consultation forums will be arranged, and the consultation will last for two months until 16 February 2025.

The Centre for Food Safety has announced on December 9 the test results of a recently completed seasonal food surveillance project on the microbiological quality of poon choi. All samples passed the tests. The spokesman reminded that the public should maintain a balanced diet and avoid eating too much food with high levels of energy, sugar, salt or fat.
