(3) CFS announces food safety report for September

CFS released the findings of its food safety report for last month on 31 October 2025. The results of about 6,600 food samples tested (including food items purchased online) were found to be satisfactory except for six unsatisfactory samples that were announced earlier. The overall satisfactory rate was 99.9 per cent.
