**(3) Test results of seasonal food surveillance project on hairy crabs all satisfactory**

The CFS announced the test results of the seasonal food surveillance project on hairy crabs on November 14. All samples passed the tests. The tests included veterinary drug residues, metallic contaminants, synthetic hormones, colouring matters and pesticide residues, as well as dioxins and dioxin-like polychlorinated biphenyls.
