The incident	FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of certain peanut butter products as well as some multi-component food items which included the peanut butter products, in the US by Harry and David, LLC, because they were produced by Sunland, Inc. and may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection. • Consumers should discard the product and not consume it. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
