<b>Heading</b>	The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) - Whole Foods Market voluntarily recalls two bulk bin items in two states due to possible health risk
<b>The incident</b>	FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of Peanut Butter Power Chews and Treasure Trove Mix by Whole Foods Market, in response to a recall by Sunridge Farms/Falcon Trading who was supplied peanut butter by Sunland, Inc. and may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to FDA, the products are distributed in certain regions of the U.S.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
