The incident	FDA issued a notice regarding the recall of Kilwins sugar Free Peanut Butter Fudge in the US by Kilwins Quality Confections, Inc. because the peanut butter used in the product is supplied by Sunland, Inc., which may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to FDA, the products are distributed in certain regions of the U.S. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection. Consumers should discard the product and not consume it. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
