Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to FDA, the affected products have been distributed in the U.S. Information on product distribution outside the U.S. is not available from the FDA website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Loose seals could results in product contamination by spoilage organisms or pathogens and lead to illness if consumed. The products manufacturer advises consumers to discard the affected batches of products and not to consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
