Heading	Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, Canberra, Australia notified the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) on a confirmed Low Pathogenic Notifiable Avian Influenza (LPNAI) H5 outbreak case that started on 14.02.2013.
The incident	LPNAI H5 was reported in Henley Brook of Western Australia. One duck from a flock of backyard poultry (ducks and chicken) was found to be infected, all backyard poultry have been destroyed.
