<b>Heading</b>	The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) - Prime Food USA Issues an Alert on <i>Listeria</i> in Latis Brand Herring Fillet "Antalja" in Oil and Latis Brand Herring Fillet in Oil with Spices
<b>The incident</b>	FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of Latis Brand Herring Fillet "Antalja" in Oil and Herring Fillet in Oil with Spices in the U.S. by Prime Food USA because the products may be contaminated with <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>According to FDA, the affected products are products of Latvia and have been distributed in certain regions of the U.S. Information on product distribution outside the U.S. is not available from FDA website.</li> <li>The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li><i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis.</li> <li>Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
