<b>Heading</b>	The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) - Certain UMNITZA (in Russian language) brand Baby Cereal products may contain mycotoxin
<b>The incident</b>	CFIA issued a notice regarding a recall of certain UMNITZA (in Russian language) brand Baby Cereal in Canada by Wonder Berry North America because they may be contaminated with mycotoxin HT-2.

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information on product distribution is not available from CFIA website.</li> <li>The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>HT-2 is a mycotoxin produced by a certain species of moulds. Consumption of food containing high level of HT-2 may cause acute poisoning. Symptoms of the poisoning may include nausea, vomiting, pharyngeal irritation, abdominal pain and distension, diarrhoea, bloody stools, dizziness, and chills.</li> <li>Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
