Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • According to FDA, the affected products have been distributed in the U.S. • Local trade has been alerted. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • The affected products may be contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i>. Ingestion of botulism toxin from the affected product may lead to serious illness and death. Symptoms of botulism include blurred or double vision, general weakness, poor reflexes, difficulty in swallowing and respiratory paralysis. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
