<b>Heading</b>	The UK Food Standards Agency (FSA) –Tesco recalls certain date codes of its Finest Sweet and Zesty Side Salad due to the undeclared presence of soya
<b>The incident</b>	The FSA issued a notice regarding a recall of certain “Finest Sweet and Zesty Side Salad” in the U.K. by Tesco because the product may contain undeclared soya.

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information on product distribution outside the U.K. is not available from the FSA website.</li> <li>The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>Consumers who are allergic to soya may develop hypersensitivity reactions, which can be life-threatening in severe cases, upon consumption of food containing soya. They are advised not to consume the product.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
