Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumption of food containing high levels of histamine can cause histamine poisoning. Symptoms of histamine poisoning include burning sensation around the mouth, facial flushing, nausea, vomiting, headache and palpitation. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary
