The incident	The Danish Veterinary and Food Administration has issued a notice that rolled pork sausage products (called rullepølse in Danish) made by Jørn A. Rullepølser A/S in Hedehusene, Denmark, are suspected to be associated with <i>Listeria</i> outbreak in Denmark. The affected products have been withdrawn from sale in Denmark.

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • According to the International Food Safety Authorities Network (INFOSAN) and the Danish Veterinary and Food Administration, the affected products have been distributed in Denmark only. • Local trade has been alerted. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
