Heading	The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS)– Recall of certain chicken nugget products in the U.S. that may be contaminated with hard plastic.
The incident	<p>The FSIS issued a notice regarding a recall of fully cooked chicken nugget products by Tyson Foods Inc., in the U.S. because the products may contain pieces of hard plastic. These included</p> <p>(1) 5-lb. bag containing "Tyson FULLY COOKED PANKO CHICKEN NUGGETS" with a "Best If Used By" date of July 18, 2017 and case code 2006SDL03 and 2006SDL33.</p> <p>(2) 20-lb. bulk packages containing "SPARE TIME Fully Cooked, Panko Chicken Nuggets, Nugget Shaped Chicken Breast Pattie Fritters With Rib Meat" with a production date of July 18, 2016 and case code 2006SDL03.</p> <p>Details of products being recalled are listed in the FSIS website.</p>
