Position of CFS	 Information on product distribution outside Ireland is not available from the FSAI website. CFS is investigating whether the affected batch has been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting relevant authority for further information. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. Investigation by CFS is ongoing. People who are allergic to egg may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen. In severe cases, anaphylactic shock may even develop. As for other members of the public, generally speaking, they would not be subject to such reactions when the
