The incident

The MPI issued a notice regarding a recall of specific batches of Haidilao brand Condiment of Spicy Hot Pot in New Zealand by Sunson Asian Food Market due to undeclared gluten.

According to MPI, wheat flour which contains gluten is declared in the Chinese ingredient list on the product label but is missing from the English ingredient list.

People who are allergic to gluten may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen.
