<b>Heading</b>	The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) – A notice regarding a recall of ready-to-eat salad with chicken products in the US by GH Foods NW, LLC due to misbranding and undeclared wheat.
<b>The incident</b>	<p>The FSIS of the USDA issued a notice regarding a recall of ready-to-eat salad with chicken products in the US by GH Foods NW, LLC due to misbranding and undeclared wheat.</p> <p>Recalled product:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ 9.2 oz. plastic clamshell packages containing “TRADER JOE’S LEMON CHICKEN &amp; ARUGULA SALAD” with “BEST BY 03/06/23” and lot code GHNW 059-06. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The products subject to recall bear establishment number “P-46987” inside the USDA mark of inspection.</li> <li>● The products are labeled with the correct top label but an incorrect bottom label.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Details of product being recalled are listed in the website of the FSIS of the USDA.</p>

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Information on product distribution outside the US is not available from the website of the FSIS of the USDA. The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) is investigating whether the affected product has been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting the relevant authority for further information. Preliminary investigation did not identify local sale or import of the affected product.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• Consumers who are allergic to wheat should discard the</li> </ul>

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product and not consume it.

- CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
- Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
- People who are allergic to wheat may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen. In severe cases, anaphylactic shock may even develop. As for other members of the public, generally speaking, they would not be subject to such reactions when the food in question is consumed.
