Recalled product:

- Red's Best chopped clams illegally harvested from prohibited waters in Massachusetts (MA) on 11/25/2023 and 11/26/2023
 - Lot numbers # 331 and # 333
 - Shuck dates of 23/331 and 23/333
 - Harvest area mhb4
 - Packed by 13027 ma-sp
 - All chopped clams were packed in one-gallon (8 lbs) plastic containers with "Red's Best" printed on the sidewall.
 - Both the lot number and shuck date should be printed on a decal label adhered to either the lid or sidewall of each container.
