Preliminary investigation did not identify local sale or import of the affected product.

- Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.
- Consumers with an allergy to hazelnuts (nuts) and/or anyone with coeliac disease and/or an allergy or intolerance to oats, wheat or gluten should discard the product and not consume it.
- CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
- Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
- People with an allergy to hazelnuts (nuts) and/or anyone with coeliac disease and/or an allergy or intolerance to oats, wheat or gluten may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen. In severe cases, anaphylactic shock may even develop. As for other members of the public, generally speaking, they would not be subject to such reactions when the food in question is consumed.
