- Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.
- Consumers with a gluten or wheat allergy or intolerance should discard the product and not consume it.
- CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
- Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
- People with a gluten or wheat allergy or intolerance may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen. In severe cases, anaphylactic shock may even develop. As for other members of the public, generally speaking, they would not be subject to such reactions when the food in question is consumed.
