Heading	The United Kingdom (UK) Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) – Notifications of pumpkin seeds products suspected to be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .
The incident	<p>The UK FSA and CFIA issued notifications to the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) regarding pumpkin seeds products suspected to be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i>. Recalled products:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ "Organic Austrian Pumpkin Seeds" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The product comes in pack size 25kg with lot # 248964, with best before date of 31 Oct 2026, and was imported by Slowood Corporation Limited. ■ "Organic Traditions brand Jumbo Pumpkin Seeds" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The product comes in 227g package marked with lot # L250212160, with used by date of 2 May 2027 and was imported by Jireh International Health Limited.
Source	The CFS received notifications from the UK FSA and CFIA.
Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preliminary investigation found that the aforementioned importers had imported into Hong Kong the products concerned but the affected batches of products have not entered the local market. The importers have discarded the concerned products. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. Besides, CFS has enhanced surveillance. Investigation by CFS is ongoing. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers should discard the products and not consume it. • <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.
