Position of CFS	- The latest follow-up investigation by the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) revealed that a trader had imported and distributed one affected batch of the concerned product (Aptamil Profutura DUO Pre D 800g, Use-by date: April 20, 2027) into the local market. The CFS has instructed the importer, distributor and retailer concerned to stop sales and remove from shelves the affected batch of the product concerned and to initiate a recall. Members of the public may call the distributor's hotline at 6426 1511 during office hours for enquiries about the recall. - The CFS urged members of the public not to let infants and young children consume the affected batches of the product, and to seek medical treatment for infants or young children who felt unwell after taking the products concerned. The trade should also stop using or selling the affected batches of the product immediately. - CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development			

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	and take appropriate actions when necessary. - Investigation by CFS is ongoing. <i>Bacillus cereus</i> is commonly found in the environment. Unhygienic conditions in food processing and storage may give rise to its growth. Consuming food contaminated with excessive <i>Bacillus cereus</i> or its heat-stable toxins may cause gastrointestinal upset such as vomiting and diarrhoea.
