Heading	The UK Food Standards Agency (FSA) and the Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) issued notices regarding the recall of specific batches of Capri-Sun Orange 10 pack in the UK and Ireland by Capri Sun UK Limited because some multipacks contain pouches incorrectly labelled as Capri-Sun Orange Zero due to a packaging error, which may mislead consumers who need to monitor their sugar intake.								
The incident	The UK FSA and the FSAI issued notices regarding the recall of specific batches of Capri-Sun Orange 10 pack in the UK and Ireland by Capri Sun UK Limited due to a packaging error. Some multipacks contain pouches incorrectly labelled as Capri-Sun Orange Zero. The pouches contain regular Capri-Sun Orange with the normal sugar level for that product, as correctly stated on the outer packaging. They do not contain the Capri-Sun Zero product. The incorrect pouch labelling may mislead consumers who need to monitor their sugar intake, including individuals with diabetes. Position of CFS	- Information on product distribution outside the UK and Ireland is not available from the websites of the FSA and the FSAI. The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) is investigating whether the affected product has been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting the relevant authority for further information. Preliminary investigation did not identify local sale or import of the affected product. - Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. - Consumers who need to manage their sugar intake should discard the product and not consume it. - CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. - Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
