Heading	The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) – Notices regarding a recall of iceberg lettuce in the US by Taylor Fresh Foods due to possible <i>Cyclospora</i> contamination.
The incident	The US FDA issued notices regarding a recall of iceberg lettuce in the US by Taylor Fresh Foods due to possible <i>Cyclospora</i> contamination. Taylor Farms de Mexico of Guanajuato, Mexico is voluntarily removing all iceberg lettuce sourced from central Mexico from the U.S. market, because it has the potential to be contaminated with <i>Cyclospora</i>. Position of CFS	Information on product distribution outside the US is not available from the websites of the FDA and the company. The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) is investigating whether the affected products have been imported to Hong Kong and has contacted the relevant authority for further information.

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	Preliminary investigation did not identify local sale or import of the affected products. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. • Investigation by CFS is ongoing. • Cyclosporiasis is an intestinal illness caused by the parasite <i>Cyclospora cayetanensis</i>. People can become infected with <i>Cyclospora</i> by consuming food or water contaminated with the parasite. The average incubation period of cyclosporiasis is about one week and common symptoms include watery diarrhoea, abdominal cramps, bloating, nausea, loss of appetite, weight loss and fatigue.
