



<u>Secondary School Food Safety and Nutrition Labelling Quiz Competition</u> <u>Prospectus of Competition – Preliminary Round</u>

(A) Format

- 1. Only one team from each school is allowed to enrol. Each team shall consist of 9 students. Secondary 1 to Secondary 6 students are welcome.
- 2. Questions are based on food safety and nutrition labelling. Related information and competition updates are available on the Centre of Food Safety (CFS) website and CFS Facebook page for students. A resource kit will be offered to each participating team on the briefing session.
- 3. Preliminary round will be a written test in form of multiple-choice questions. All questions are written in traditional Chinese. Contestants have to complete 30 questions within 30 minutes.
- 4. Preliminary round will be held on 29 March 2014 (Sat) at Lai Chi Kok Government Offices, 19 Lai Chi Kok Road, Kln (To be confirmed). The test is tentatively scheduled from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (To be confirmed).

(B) Rules and Regulations

- 1. Participating teams must arrive at the venue at the designated time for registration. Each student shall bring their student identity card for verification purpose.
- 2. Contestants must wear tidy school uniform.
- 3. Each contestant will be assigned with a serial number. Student must be seated according to the arrangement of the Organiser.
- 4. Contestants shall bring their own stationery and use calculator approved by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority. (Calculator should be marked with 「H.K.E.A.A. APPROVED」 or 「H.K.E.A. APPROVED」)
- 5. Each contestant shall complete and submit an answer sheet individually. No talking during the test.
- 6. Only one answer should be chosen for each question. Equal marks are awarded for each question. No marks will be deducted for incorrect answers.
- 7. No changes are allowed once the answer sheet is submitted.
- 8. Contestants will not be allowed to use any kind of electronic devices, including camera, mobile phones or tablet. They will not be allowed to bring reference material or paper with them during the test. Participating teams shall not disclose any information about the questions in the preliminary round.
- 9. Contestants can only leave the venue when the test is finished.
- 10. The team score will be the total score of all team members. Nine teams with the highest total scores will enter the semi-final round.
- 11. A list of teams for the semi-final round will be announced within one week after the test. Teams entering the semi-final round will be notified separately.
- 12. The Organiser has the final right on deciding answers of the test.
- 13. Contestants cheat at the test will cause disqualification of the entire team.

- 14. If any contestant is unable to attend the test for some special reasons, the participating school could submit a written application for replacement. A replacement may be accepted if the reason is valid.
- 15. Any contestant who is absent from the test without prior notice will be disqualified.
- 16. Rules of the semi-final round will be announced in February-March 2014. Teams entering the semi-final round will be notified separately.
- 17. The Organiser reserves the right to make modifications to the competition format and rules.

(C) Special Weather Arrangement

- 1. If Typhoon Cyclone signal No. 3 or Amber / Red rainstorm warning is in force on the event day, the competition will be held as scheduled.
- 2. If Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above or a Black Rainstorm Warning is in force at 7:00 a.m. on the event day, the competition will be cancelled. Contestants will be informed of the rescheduled date.
- 3. If Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted during the competition, the competition will be suspended immediately. Participants will be informed of the rescheduled date.
