Dr. Duncan Craig joined Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) in 2003 and has been the Principal Microbiologist and Manager of the Risk Assessment – Microbiology Section since 2009.

Dr. Craig leads a team of scientific staff that undertakes microbiological risk assessments to inform development of national food standards. This includes the completion of complex through-chain risk assessments for the dairy, poultry, egg, meat and seafood industries. Dr. Craig also provides expert advice for the coordination of national food incidents, imported food and surveillance activities. He has delivered a number of international training courses on microbiological risk assessment and undertaken consultations for the World Health Organization and the Food and Agriculture Organization.

Dr. Craig has qualifications and experience in the field of environmental health. He obtained his PhD from Flinders University, with research in the area of water microbiology and risk assessment.

Dr. Craig 擁有環境衛生方面的資歷和經驗。他是弗林德斯大學博士，研究範疇為水微生物學及風險評估。
